

What is PARS Group?

A key degree for the present and the future

Academic Programme with Successive Pathway (PARS) in Informatics Engineering: allows students to registration in the Bachelor's Degree in Informatics Engineering and then continue their studies in the Master's Degree in Informatics Engineering, even if they have pending elective subjects and/or the TFG, with a maximum of 30 ECTS credits pending in total. Register in the PARS does not imply the obligation to complete the degree plus the master's degree, and students may leave the PARS at any time.

For the academic year, 100 places have been established for this academic program. They are offered the same enrolment groups as the rest of the students admitted to the Bachelor's Degree in Informatics Engineering. However, whenever there are vacancies, it is recommended that they choose the groups with teaching in ENGLISH, 1E1 and 1E2 and the groups with teaching in SPANISH, 1D1 and 1D2, both with morning shift teaching.

NEW STUDENTS: Remember that in the pre-enrolment application form you can select, if you wish, these two access routes (Bachelor's Degree in Informatics Engineering and (PARS) in Informatics Engineering).
