

PROTOCOL FOR REQUESTING INSTRUMENTS OR SOFTWARE FROM THE LABORATORIES BY STUDENTS IN THE DOCTORAL PROGRAM

Any student enrolled in the Interuniversity Doctorate Program in Geodesy may request the instruments or software of any of the laboratories of the department (the inventory, together with the persons in charge of each laboratory, can be found in the laboratories section of the department's web page).

The protocol to be followed for any request will be:

Request by the thesis director in writing by e-mail to the laboratory manager with a copy to the deputy director of infrastructure.

The laboratory manager manages the exit and entry of the instruments, which, for this type of request, should not overlap with teaching practical or field trips.

For drones it will be necessary that the person using it has the corresponding qualifications to be able to fly it and is UPV staff.

Commercial software is installed on laboratory computers (if the number of licenses allows it, it can also be installed on seminar computers), but not on the students' own computers.
