Estimated budget	Average budget: around 600 ~ 700 euros/month for living expenses (food & single room accommodation)
Health insurance (compulsory)	> For European students: European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)
	> For non-European students: Health care expenses can be reimbursed by the French Social Security system.

	To be covered at least the first 2 months of their stay in France, we highly recommend students to purchase a private health insurance before leaving their home country. It takes some time to be registered by the French Social Security System.
Complementary insurance	For a higher reimbursement rate, it is highly recommended to take out an additional medical insurance (around 20€/month).
Civil liability (compulsory)	Civil liability and repatriation (around 20€/year)
