Ireland, along with the UK, France, Germany and the other EU countries is part of the Bologna process which ensures mutual recognition of qualifications across Europe and the world. The Irish National Framework of Qualifications system is fully compatible with the ENIC-NARIC (European Network of Information Centres/National Academic Recognition Information Centres), which further facilitates the recognition of academic qualifications throughout Europe and internationally in countries such as the USA, Canada, Australia and New Zealand.

Many IT Tralee degrees are recognised by relevant independent professional bodies where applicable for example ACCA (accounting), Chartered Accountants, and Engineers Ireland in their respective fields.

WORK READY GRADUATES:

The Institute of Technology Tralee provides bachelor & masters degrees focused on delivering practical knowledge and building real world skills to help graduates get jobs quickly and build great careers.

IT Tralee believes in making our graduates more valuable to employers through practical classes, hands on workshops and real world problem solving skills.

GET REAL WORLD INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE DURING YOUR DEGREE

The vast majority of IT Tralee programmes include a minimum of 1 semester work placement (internships).

Students who do their work placement in another EU country can apply for grant support under the EU Erasmus + programme. In a typical example, last year a student going to the UK for 3 months for work placement received a grant of €1000.

STAY BACK -WORK IN IRELAND AFTER GRADUATION!

The Irish Government through the Third Level Graduate Scheme allows graduates to stay in Ireland and work after their programme finishes.

Once they have successfully completed their programme graduates from bachelor (Level 08 Honours) programmes can stay and work for up to 12 months and masters (Level 09) graduates can stay and work for up to 24 months.

IRISH ECONOMY & INTERNATIONAL COMPANIES



Ireland is Europe's fastest growing economy and has been for a number of years. It has one of the most advanced and competitive telecommunications infrastructures in Europe and it is the world's 2nd largest exporter of software and computer services. Some prominent examples are Amazon, Apple, Cisco, Intel, Microsoft, EMC, Dropbox, eBay, Facebook, Google, Hewlett-Packard, LinkedIn, Oracle, PayPal and Twitter.

It has a huge pharmaceutical sector and approximately 120 overseas companies have plants in Ireland including 9 of the 10 largest pharmaceutical companies in the world.

Other important sectors of the Irish economy include financial services, agriculture, food, commercial aviation and tourism.

MAJOR INDUSTRIES LOCALLY:

Agriculture & Food are important to the local economy. Kerry Group, the world's largest food ingredients company has its global HQ in Tralee. Engineering is important too with Dairymaster, the world's largest Dairy engineering company located near Tralee, and Liebherr Group one of the world's largest crane companies within a few minutes drive.


As is the case across Ireland, the local ICT and Financial Services & Pharmaceutical sectors are important employers providing many well paid high value jobs.

DO I NEED A VISA TO GO TO IRELAND?

- All non-EU/EEA students must comply with Irish immigration requirements.
- We recommend that all non-EU/EEA applicants visit the Irish Naturalisation and Immigration Service website http://www.inis.gov.ie/en/INIS/pages/study for the most up to date information.
- At the time of writing passport holders from Schedule 1 countries (including USA, Canada, Hong Kong, Malaysia, Republic of Korea) can enter Ireland without an entry visa.
- Citizens of China, Nigeria, Russia and India can apply to the Embassy of Ireland in their home country for a visa.
- Don't hesitate to contact us for more information about visas, we're happy to help.
- All non-EU/EEA students who will study in Ireland for 3 months or more must get a GNIB card within 30 days of arrival we will help you do that after you arrive so don't worry about that too much.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Contact the IT Tralee local representative office to make your application or if there is no local office you can email us directly at international@ ittralee.ie

We understand that most applicants will not have visited Ireland before. We make arriving in Ireland as stress free as possible. We meet you at the airport and provide a free transfer to Tralee on first arrival.

We also include free emergency medical insurance for all non EU/EEA fee paying students. We hope you will never need it but either way it's one less thing we want you or your family to worry about.

WHERE CAN I LIVE?

Tralee has lots of high quality affordable accommodation available for students. Usually international students live in an apartment (often in a private room with private bathroom) typically with 2 other students - all apartments have a well equipped kitchen and a living room often with free WIFI included.

The international office will help you book your accommodation if you wish.

TUITION FEES:

Tuition Fees €9,950 per academic year.


