



Tips for your students course selection

ESIGELEC uses the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). The usual workload for an ESIGELEC student is 30 ECTS credits per semester. Exchange students can choose between 20 ECTS credits min. to 30 ECTS credits max. per semester.

Students must match the course prerequisites for a successful study at ESIGELEC.

Students must choose courses from a single programme. Students cannot choose different courses from different programmes nor courses from the same programme but on different years.

A Learning agreement must be signed before the beginning of the mobility. ESIGELEC is connected to EWP and can sign digital learning agreements. Exchange students are exempted from tuiton fees at ESIGELEC.

Why should your students choose ESIGELEC?

Pre-arrival webinars:

Organized prior to the students' arrival in France to help them adapt seamlessly to student life in France.

Airport pick up:

ESIGELEC will send a bus for a pick up at airport Paris Charles de Gaulle on a specific day before each intake, in order to drive the students to their accomodation in Rouen

Welcome Days:

Upon arrival at ESIGELEC, students will attend orientation sessions such as : student life in Rouen, digital tools, etc.

READY-SET-GO Forum:

Our different partners assist students with administrative processes such as opening a French bank account, applying for health insurance, obtaining a French mobile phone plan, applying for housing allowance, etc.



ESIGELEC holds "Bienvenue en France" label with a 2-star rating. This label is awarded to institutions wishing to highlight their welcome programmes.



General information

Visa requirements:

EU citizens: no visa is required.

Non EU citizens: a visa is required, more information about visas is available on the French government website or at the nearest Campus France office, French consulate, or embassy.

Accommodation:

ESIGELEC does not have its own student residences. However, ESIGELEC holds a partnership with Studapart, a housing plateform which offers a wide range of accommodation for students in the city of Rouen.

-Average rent: 450 euros/month.

-Approximate cost of living: 800 euros/month (including rent, tranportation, food, etc.).

Students may also contact for any accommodation related question our housing service (Logement@esigelec.fr).

Health insurance:

-EU students must hold the European Health Insurance Card -Non EU-students must have a private medical insurance upon arrival in France, valid for least the 3 first months in France. Once in France, they must apply for the French mandatory medical insurance (which is free of charge).

Other insurances:

Students must also have civil liability insurance, repatriation insurance and accommodation insurance covering the entire duration of their stay in France.



International visiting Professors

ESIGELEC welcomes 50 visiting professors and experts to its campus each year for teaching. We aim to foster exchange of good practises and collaborative projects led by professors from around the world.

With a professional approach that highlights international engineering, our body of international visiting professors consists of faculty members from our partner universities.

Professors from Erasmus+ partner universities can teach under the Erasmus+ Staff Mobility for Teaching Assignments (STA) framework.

Arrival and stay:

Visiting professors receive support for their arrival in France from the International Relations office.

We offer services such as flight booking, airport pick-up from Paris to Rouen and hotel reservation.
